

In April 2011, detectives with the Department of Insurance ("DOI") requested to be reimbursed for purchasing their own soft body armor as set forth in Article 13.1.C of Bargaining Unit 7 Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"). CSLEA's contract provides "that employees who upgrade their soft body armor by purchasing their own soft body armor will be reimbursed in

an amount equal to the cost of the state provided armor, with a receipt and consistent with the Department's replacement <u>read more</u>
