Keeping you informed:

On Friday, September 1, 2017, Governor Jerry Brown signed Assembly Bill 1459, a bill that California FOP supported and Assembly Bill 1024 which California FOP opposed. You will find links to the bills and our letters below.

In addition, the following action was taken on California FOP priority bills that were on the suspense file:

[SB 54](#) (deLeon) Law enforcement sharing data passed with Republicans voting no.

[SB 386](#) (Glazer) State beaches and parks smoking ban passed with Republicans voting no.

[SB 21](#) (Hill) Law enforcement agencies: surveillance policies was held on the suspense file.

[SB 505](#) (Mendoza) Shared gang database: administration was held on the suspense file.

[SB 384](#) (Wiener) Alcoholic beverages: hours of sale passed with amendments to strike the contents and instead create a task force to study the issue of bars staying open past 2 a.m.

[AB 1028](#) (Bocanegra) Workers' compensation was held on the suspense file.

[AB 175](#) (Chau) Cannabis marking: packaging and labeling was held on the suspense file.

[AB 371](#) (Cooley) Sex crimes: communication with a minor was held on the suspense file.

[AB 530](#) (Cooper) Collective bargaining: peace officers passed, 5-2, with Republicans voting no.

[AB 725](#) (Levine) State beaches and parks: smoking ban passed with amendments to reduce the fine to \$50 and exempt Native American ceremonial purposes. The bill passed 5-2, with Republicans voting no.


[AB 1428](#) (Low) Peace officers: transparency was held on the suspense file.

[AB 284](#) (McCarty) DOJ: Officer-involved shootings report was held on the suspense file.

[AB 301](#) (Rodriguez) Commercial motor vehicles: exam requirements: driving skills test was held on suspense.

[AB 1250](#) (Jones-Sawyer) Contracts for personal services was referred to Senate Rules.
