We are devasted by the senseless ends to the lives of these law enforcement officers who were all doing their jobs to protect and serve. May they rest in peace, may their families know how incredibly brave their

loved one was, and may their departments feel the love of the communities they serve. A law enforcement officer's job is never easy, dealing with these losses, makes it that more difficult.

In closing, I hope you will take a moment to read "Catastrophic Time Bank Set Up for Hospital Police Officer Luz Benitez" below. Officer Benitez is a CSLEA/HPAC member and could certainly use our support as she and her family head into a difficult 2019. COALINGA – When your child is seriously ill, and his medical benefits are provided by your employer, the last thing you want to do is lose your job and consequently your health insurance. Facing that possibility is Coalinga State Hospital Police Officer Luz Benitez. 

FAMILY PLANNING?

Pregnancy Disability Income Benefit through Allstate Benefits

CSLEA members have the opportunity to receive disability income up to \$1800 a month for pregnancy leave through Allstate Benefits. The accident policy provides on-or- off the job, 24 hour, accidental disability income and has a sickness disability income rider which includes pregnancy income.

The illness rider coverage has to be purchased as part of the accident policy. In addition to income for time off due to illness or surgery, the rider will cover maternity as any other illness, provided the policy has been in effect 10 months at time of birth. This means that coverage is not available if you are currently pregnant.


