#### **CONTRACT UPDATE:**

SACRAMENTO - In the afternoon hours on September 12, 2019, the California State Legislature passed Assembly Bill 118 enabling the California Statewide Law Enforcement Association (CSLEA) Tentative Agreement. The bill will now be sent to Governor Gavin Newsom for signature.

CSLEA is in communication with the State to determine how and when employees will receive their salary increases and adjustments retroactive to July 1, 2019.

Hello CSLEA members,
We received the good news late yesterday afternoon that the
legislature passed our Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
bill. This puts us another step closer to seeing salary

increases and adjustments in our paychecks. AB 118 will now be sent to the governor for his signature. CSLEA will keep in touch with the state to determine how your increases retroactive to July 1, 2019 will be paid. We are all anxious to see our MOU in its final stages

of implementation.

I want to thank all of you for your patience during the lengthy process of negotiations, ratification and the implementation of our contract. Please know that our work does not stop here. As you will read in <u>CSLEA and CSLB Work Toward Better Pay for Enforcement Representatives</u>, even as our tentative agreement was making its way to the Capitol, CSLEA continued, and still continues, to work on a number of ongoing pay, benefit and working condition issues impacting members. We know there is more work to be done and are working toward future side letters. We will keep you updated.

Looking ahead to next week, National Forensic Science week, I would like to recognize our members who contribute greatly to public safety and criminal justice in this state, and that's our forensic science professionals at the California Department of Justice! I have the greatest respect for the work that you do. So many cases would go unsolved without your work. Your work is the weight behind convictions and exonerations! Enjoy the week that celebrates you! You deserve it. Thank you for your service to the State of California.



#### **FAMILY PLANNING?**

Pregnancy Disability Income Benefit through Allstate Benefits

CSLEA members have the opportunity to receive disability income up to \$1800 a month for pregnancy leave through Allstate Benefits. The accident policy provides on-or- off the

job, 24 hour, accidental disability income and has a sickness disability income rider which includes pregnancy income.

The illness rider coverage has to be purchased as part of the accident policy. In addition to income for time off due to illness or surgery, the rider will cover maternity as any other illness, provided the policy has been in effect 10 months at time of birth. This means that coverage is not available if you are currently pregnant.


