Legislation To Arm Hospital Police



In an effort to keep our state hospital police officers and surrounding communities safe, CSLEA was behind AB 2623 one hundred percent.

AB 2623 would require the Department of State Hospitals, by June 30, 2013, to adopt a policy regarding arming peace officers of state hospitals. The bill passed the Assembly and Senate and as of Friday, September 15th, the bill is on the Governor's desk.
