In an effort to keep California Statewide Law Enforcement Association (CSLEA) members updated on law enforcement and public safety legislation, please find below a list of some of the bills the Governor took action on yesterday, September 30, 2018, including:

- [AB 748](#) (Ting) regarding peace officer audio and video recording disclosure was signed.
- [AB 2255](#) (Lackey) cannabis distribution deliveries violations was vetoed. In his [veto message](#), Governor Brown said this was premature and could be handled through regulations.
- [AB 2992](#) (Daly) peace officer training: commercial sexual exploitation of children was signed.
- [SB 1421](#) (Skinner) peace officers release of records was signed.
- [SB 1449](#) (Leyva) rape kit testing was vetoed. In his [veto message](#), Governor Brown said this would be completed through an audit first.
