LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The California 2025 legislative session has concluded.

On the calendar for 2026:

- January 5 The 2026 legislative session begins.
- January 31 The deadline for bills to pass their house of origin; any not passed are dead.
- June 15 Deadline for the Legislature to pass the budget bill.
- August 31 -The last day for the Legislature to complete almost all bills for the session.
- September 30 The last day for the Governor to sign or veto bills passed before the final recess.
- November 3 General Election.
- November 30 Final adjournment of the 2026 session.

• December 7 - The 2027-28 Regular Session convenes.

Of Note:

The California legislature operates on a two-year cycle, so the 2026 calendar year is the second year of the 2025-2026 legislative session.
