The Law Enforcement Mutual-Aid Training Course is a 2-day, 16-hour California POST-approved course presented by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services Law Enforcement Mutual-Aid Coordinators. This training is specifically designed for law enforcement professionals who have law enforcement mutual-aid responsibilities within their agencies. This course provides a foundational understanding of California's Law Enforcement Mutual-Aid System and is delivered in a format that emphasizes both theory and practices. Participants are guided through key concepts and processes and will validate their understanding and decision-making skills during a Tabletop Exercise (TTX) on the final day.

Course Objectives:

This 16-hour POST- approved course aims to ensure that participants are able to:

- Describe the structure and purpose of the California Law Enforcement Mutual-Aid System.
- Understand agency roles and responsibilities at the local, regional, and state levels.
- Understand Mutual-Aid authorities under the California Emergency Services Act
- Explain the coordination process for requesting and deploying law enforcement mutual-aid resources
- Identify planning considerations for pre-event and emergency mutual-aid operations
- Evaluate resource management, communications protocols,

- and operational coordination within a mutual-aid environment
- Apply key concepts in a Tabletop exercise simulation a real-world mutual-aid event.
 - Develop knowledge of the Law Enforcement Mutual-Aid Plan (LEMA) Blue Book and develop an understanding of the Incident Action Plan process related to LEMA
